Federal Funds for Special Education

Findlay City Schools receives federal funds for handicapped students as provided by the 1 Amendments to the Individual with Disabilities Education Act. These funds are provided as an incentive to expand and improve services for the handicapped, ages 3 through 21. In our district has allocated funds for the following:

- Paraprofessionals to assist in classrooms
- Coordinator of Secondary Special Education Programs
- School Psychologist
- Medical evaluations required for students to be placed or maintained in a special education program
- A consultant for visually-handicapped students
- A part-time school psychologist for the parochial school
- A part-time school pathologist for the parochial school
- Teacher(s) of students with multiple disabilities
- Support for an after-school program for behaviorally challenged, disabled student
